Dr. Tuazon is a retired full professor and past dean of the College of Nursing, University of the Philippines Manila and is still connected with the same university as a professorial lecturer. Aside from her master's degree in nursing, her doctorate is in public health, specializing in health promotion and health education.

She is a member of the Philippine Health Technology Assessment Council which was established through the Universal Health Care Act (HTAC) in 2019. HTAC is responsible for assessing and giving recommendations for new technologies to be purchased by DOH and/or reimbursed by PhilHealth.

She holds leadership positions in various nursing and multidisciplinary groups, national and international, to name a few: CHED Technical Evaluators for Nursing Education, ASEAPS or the Association of Southeast Asian Pain Societies, APANE or the Asia Pacific Association of Nursing Education, Pain Society of the Philippines, Philippine Association of Diabetes Educators, International Council on Women's Health Issues Inc (ICOWHI), East Asian Forum of Nursing Scholars (EAFONS), and founding president of the UP Honor Society of Nursing, which is now a chapter of STTI. She is engaged in research and is panel chair and reviewer of the UP Manila Research Ethics Board.
