Sok Ying's **PRIME** research focuses on **P**atient safety with emphasis on: **R**ecognising and responding to clinical deterioration; **I**nterprofessional collaboration and education, **M**anpower nursing workforce and development and; **E**xperiential learning using simulation. She has led the development and evaluation of simulation-based educational programmes including **e-RAPIDS** (**R**escuing **A** **P**atient **I**n **D**eterioration **S**ituation) and **CREATIVE** (**C**reate **R**eal-time **A**nd **T**eamwork **I**n **V**irtual **E**nvironment) which were translated into curriculums and licensed to overseas institutions. She has gained support from several research grants with a total of over \$3.3 million funding as a Principal or Co-investigator. She has strived to publish high quality papers and earned herself an H-index over 20 and Field Weighted Citation Impact (FWCI) above 2. Currently she is an associate editor (Clinical Simulation in Nursing) and editorial board member (BMC Nursing) for nursing journals.
